# **Identify physical supports for Tamiya**

# Objective(s)

Learners will view photos of a classroom and identify specific physical supports a child with disabilities needs.

## **Description**

In this activity, learners view photos of Tamiya's new classroom and identify the specific physical supports available and areas of need for additional supports to support her adjustment.

### **Required Materials/Resources**

#### **Learner Materials**

Format for learner responses (written activity form, guidance for discussion)

#### **Detailed Facilitator Instructions**

- 1. Have learners review the photos on the Activity 2.5a learner form.
- 2. Ask learners to answer the following questions:
  - a. Identify three specific physical supports available.
  - b. What other activities or areas of the classroom should Tamiya's teacher be sure to evaluate to identify other supports that may be needed?
- 3. Provide feedback.
